

RISE Homework Policy

Whatever your hand finds to do, do it with all your might. Ecclesiastes 9:10

RISE is dedicated to helping Christian parents support their children in the ways of the Lord. Hard work is a gift from God that teaches steadfastness, diligence, and perseverance. According to the Scriptures, (Proverbs 22:6) those who learn these character traits while they are young will reap good habits and be satisfied with a lifetime of rewarding achievements. With this principle in mind, RISE challenges students to fulfill their academic responsibilities in order to reach their full God-given potential.

Students are expected to complete RISE homework assignments on time and with integrity. Parents must be willing to provide an in home learning environment and to oversee homework completion. Completed homework assignments will be checked or collected in class in accordance with each RISE Teacher methods. Weekly homework completion is mandatory and a prerequisite for classroom participation.

RISE understands circumstances may arise causing students to temporarily fall behind on homework responsibilities due to sickness, travel, or transformative life events. In such cases, parents should email each RISE Teacher involved and Directors. RISE Teacher may re-set due dates or re-define the workload as is appropriate for each situation.

Habitual, unexcused homework incompletion compromises the student's academic well-being and will result in an Teacher-parent written notification (text, email). Out of the same concerns, families of students with failing (60% or lower) scores must meet with Directors and the Teacher of the class to discuss options for success and to give the student a final opportunity to turn in missing work. Unless improvement is made by the end of the current semester, the student will be removed from the class for the remaining semester/school year with no financial reimbursement and will be blocked from Registration the following year.

RISE strictly enforces this homework policy. The student and parents commitment and signature is required to complete the registration process. This form must be uploaded to the RISE website or handed into the RISE Teachers on or before the first day of class.

The following verses may be useful for families studying the character trait of diligence: Proverbs 10:4, 12:14, 13:4, 14:23, 21:5, Ecclesiastes 9:10, and Galatians 6:9.
